

Town of Carney Special Council Meeting Notice, Agenda, and Minutes

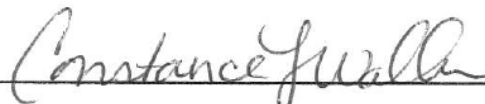

Meeting was called to order by Mayor Constance Wallace at 6:00pm. Joe Simon left during Executive Session.
